Pedibus is a swarm of children walking back and forth to school under the leadership of an adult. Parents enrolling their children for Pedibus commit themselves at the same time to lead them in turn when needed.

## It is easy to create a Pedibus line!

### 1 Involve other parents

Bring interested families together: two are enough to launch a Pedibus line!

### 2 Contact your Pedibus coordinators

They help you to start the line and provide you with the safety equipment.

### 3 Define the way it works

Itinerary, stops and rules of your line are decided with the other parents.

## Pedibus: how does it work?

It is very simple and it works like a real bus, but on foot.

- Itinerary and timetable are decided according to the families' needs.
- Leaders are parents or trustworthy adults.
- Children join Pedibus at the closest stop, which is indicated by a sign.
